
## Regarding Tuition Pattern for 2014~2015

We want to assure everyone that there will be a very minimal increase and make everyone aware of all financial assistance available. An outline for tuition rates for next school year will be compared to the tuition and tithing model we currently use.

# Extended Days Next Week for Westside Catholic School

**Monday, February 24 – Monday, March 3, 2014**

Westside Catholic School is going to follow the Extended Day model for loss of instructional days. The Indiana Department of Education has offered this to all schools in order to make up days when schools were not in session due to bad weather. Evansville Vanderburgh School Corporation and Mater Dei High School will also be adding one hour of instruction a day, for six consecutive days, to make up one snow day.

This will begin next **Monday, February 24 and run through Monday, March 3, 2014.** We will start at our regular times and dismiss at 3:20 p.m. at St. Agnes and 3:30 p.m. at St. Boniface. The teachers and I feel it will be more convenient for our school families that rely on public school bus transportation and for those that have a sibling at MD that pick up our younger students.

This does not affect our Preschool classes at Sacred Heart. They will be operating at their normal times and have made accommodations for some make-up days and times. Their last day of school will remain the same, Friday, May 16, 2014.

In turn, this means we will not need to use our 5<sup>th</sup> make-up day scheduled for Friday, May 23, 2014. The last day of school for Westside Catholic School (Kindergarten – Grade 8) will be **Thursday, May 22, 2014.**

Dear Parents of Grades 3-8,

The week of on March 3-7, Westside Catholic School will be administering the Applied Skills portion of the state mandated ISTEP+ testing. The second part of the testing is the Multiple Choice portion and will be administered April 28 – May 2, 2013.

Both testing portions cover English/Language Arts and Mathematics. Grades 4 and 6 will have a Science portion and grades 5 and 7 will have a Social Studies portion. Just so you are aware, the March exam will be completed entirely in paper/pencil form. Only grades 6, 7 and 8 will be utilizing the ISTEP+ Multiple Choice portion on-line in April/May.

A healthy snack is being provided by our P.T.O. for the students each morning to help them refuel and do their best. Students may bring in bottled water with a lid to have during testing days. Please make sure their name is on the bottle and students are to have it refilled each morning.

ISTEP+ is always an exciting time for your child to demonstrate the academic progress that has been made this year. We encourage you to discuss the ISTEP+ test with your child and discuss its importance in measuring academic achievements.

Parents can assist their children by making sure so they are physically and mentally ready to take the tests on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday (as a make-up day for Jr. High). Here is how you can help:


- Make sure your child goes to bed early and has at least 8 hours of rest prior to each testing day.
- Send a full bottle of water with your child on each testing day. *(Please don't have them wait until the beginning of school to fill their bottle as it delays our testing schedule.)*
- Make sure your child has a good breakfast before coming to school.
- Make sure your child is on time for school, if not a little earlier than usual.
- Your child's attendance is always important, but it is pertinent on these testing days.

Encourage your child to do their best work, but also reassure them that they need to be relaxed for the test. Our students always do an outstanding job, so the students will do especially well if they are relaxed and come well prepared. Thanks you for corporation.

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
