4th Annual Variety Show



Safe Environment Program For Youth Protection

Required for all Westside Catholic School Volunteers

As part of the Diocese of Evansville Safe Environment Program for Youth Protection, along with dioceses all over the country, every adult over the age of 18 who works with children or who has regular contact with children must have on file proof of a clear background history check. This is a directive given to all bishops in the United States being carried throughout our diocese.

All volunteers, employees, and catechist working with youth are also required to attend one of the Safe Environment Informational Training Programs before working with our youth by assisting with field trips, class parties, teaching youth religious education classes, youth group activities, etc. The following training programs are scheduled for your convenience:

<u>Tuesday, September 9, 6:00 p.m.</u> at our Elementary Campus in Guerin Hall (St. Agnes)

Or New Date:

Wednesday, September 17, 10:00 a.m. at our Preschool Campus in the cafeteria (Sacred Heart)

After the presentation, you will be asked to sign a "Best Practices for Pastoral Conduct" page to be placed in your file. The background checks will be processed at no cost to you and the results are kept confidential.

Youth Protection Renewals

Each year, all volunteers are required to renew your pledge to abide by the Diocesan policy of "Best Practices." Youth Protection Renewal is simple and easy. We will send out all renewals early this fall. If you have kept current on your Youth Protection Renewal, you will be receiving a renewal form with your name on it. Please read the information, sign and return in to school as soon as possible. Your cooperation with our continued effort to provide a safe environment for our children is greatly appreciated.

TRI-CAP OFFERS FREE FLU SHOTS

TRI-CAP is partnering with local Walgreens stores to offer free flu shot clinics at each TRI-CAP location. Flu shots will be provided for anyone in need. Please bring your insurance information. If you are uninsured, we will have someone available to assist you. Ages 7-10 can be vaccinated with a doctor's prescription and ages 11+ can be vaccinated with parental consent. People should be vaccinated against the flu once each year. An annual flu vaccine is the best way to reduce the chances of getting the flu and spreading it to others. Getting vaccinated is a great way to try to prevent future doctor visits during flu season.
