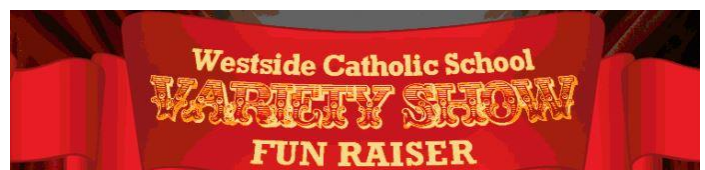
Fall Festival

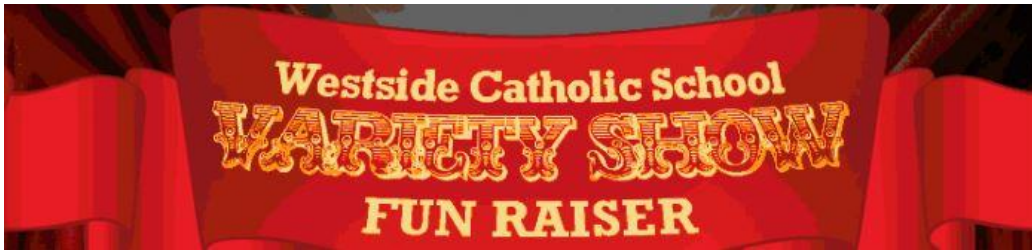
