The School Reach broadcast system enables our school to notify all households and parents by phone or email within minutes of an emergency or unplanned event that causes early dismissal, school cancellation or school delays. It will show as St. Boniface School (812-422-1014) on your caller ID. If you have missed the call from us, please wait a minute or two and it will have time to record in your voice mail.

If you need to change your phone numbers, email addresses or you are not receiving the calls or emails, please notify the school office.

The general rule is, when Westside Catholic School is closed or cancelled:

- All school programs associated with the school are closed.
- All extra-curricular activities such as athletic events, fine arts events and performances, are cancelled.
- Practices may be held, but attendance will be voluntary.
- Extended Daycare Programs are closed.
